IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Relating to the Compilation and Printing of the History of Selective Service in Maine.

Compilation and printing of History of Selective Service. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$1,800 from the general fund to compile, print and distribute a record of the history of Selective Service in Maine during the period of World War II, under the direction of the office of the adjutant-general and the director of selective service during World War II.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This compilation is to preserve the record of the operation of selective service in Maine during World War II, including a record of all uncompensated personnel who served in various capacities and a record of the compensated military personnel.
