RESOLVE Relating to Fishing in Rocky Pond and Johnson Pond in Knox
County.

Fishing in Rocky pond and Johnson pond regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation establishing a daily bag limit of 5 fish, with a minimum length of 8 inches, in fishing the waters of Rocky pond in the town of Rockport and Johnson pond in the town of Appleton, both in Knox county.
