IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

RESOLVE Authorizing the State Plumbers' Examining Board to Issue a License to Philip M. Emmott of Southwest Harbor.

State plumbers' examining board authorized to issue license. Resolved: That the state plumbers' examining board be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue to Philip M. Emmott of Southwest Harbor, Hancock county, a master and a journeyman plumbers' license without taking the examinations provided by law.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Emmott has lived in Maine since 1928. He holds a master plumber's license from Massachusetts and is 69 years of age and should be able to hold such a license from the state of Maine without taking an examination.
