STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relative to Extending Hunting Season on Deer.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new paragraph to read as follows:

'Whenever any portion of the state is closed to hunting by proclamation of the governor during the open season on deer, the commissioner of inland fisheries and game with the consent of the governor and council is hereby authorized to extend the open season for deer hunting for a period of not more than 2 weeks, which period shall not total more than 2/3 of the time lost in those portions of the state affected by the proclamation.'
