AN ACT Relating to Probation in Sexual Crimes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 117, § 12-A, additional. Chapter 117 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 12-A, to read as follows:

‘Sec. 12-A. Probation. Whoever is adjudged guilty under the provisions of sections 10 to 12, inclusive, shall not be eligible to probation.’

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 121, § 8-A, additional. Chapter 121 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 8-A, to read as follows:

‘Sec. 8-A. Probation. Whoever is adjudged guilty under the provisions of sections 1 to 8, inclusive, shall not be eligible to probation.’
