IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Duties of Attorney General.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 17, § 1-A, additional. Chapter 17 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 1-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 1-A. Attorney general to defend certain state officers. All civil actions for false arrest brought against police officers, sea and shore fisheries wardens and inland fish and game wardens of the state shall be defended by the attorney general.'
