AN ACT Relating to Clerk Hire in County Offices in Somerset County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 269, amended. That part of section 269 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to clerk hire in Somerset county, as amended by section 7 of chapter 280 of the public laws of 1945, and by chapter 293 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Somerset county: for clerks in the office of register of deeds, ~~\$3,800~~ \$4,800; for clerks in the office of register of probate, ~~\$1,500~~ \$2,000; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, ~~\$2,000~~ \$2,500, and such additional amounts as may be authorized by the county commissioners.'
