STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Salaries of the Judge of Probate and Register of Probate, Franklin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 140, § 3, amended. That part of section 3 of chapter 140 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of the judge of probate of Franklin county, as amended by section 7 of chapter 161 of the public laws of 1945 and by section 2 of chapter 371 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Franklin, \$1,000 **\$1,200**,'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 140, § 22, amended. That part of section 22 of chapter 140 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of the register of probate of Franklin county, as amended by section 6 of chapter 161 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Franklin, \$1,250 \$1,500,'

Sec. 3. Effective date. The provisions of this act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1949.
