STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Road Equipment on Private Ways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 84, § 31-A, additional. Chapter 84 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 31-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 31-A. Use of highway equipment on private ways. The selectmen of any town may authorize the use of its highway equipment on private ways within such town, whenever such selectmen deem it advisable for the best interests of the town and towns may expend a portion of the tax moneys collected from residents and non-residents upon private ways.'
