Regulating fishing in Long pond, in the county of Franklin. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing tributaries to Long pond, in Sandy River Plantation, in the county of Franklin, to all fishing.
