**RESOLVE** Regulating Fishing in Haley Pond, in the County of Franklin.

---

**Regulating fishing in Haley pond, in the county of Franklin. Resolved:**  
That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing Haley pond, in the town of Rangeley and Dallas plantation, in the county of Franklin, to all fishing except fly fishing, and closing all tributaries.
