**RESOLVE Authorizing the Sale of Hatcheries and Feeding Station
Property.**

Sale of hatcheries and feeding station property authorized. Resolved:
That the state tax assessor is hereby authorized to sell for the department of inland fisheries and game the land and building comprising the Rangeley feeding station in Rangeley to Emil Caccavo of 72 Carmine street, New York 14, N. Y. for \$1,000.
