**RESOLVE** Regulating Fishing in Red River, in Aroostook County.

---

**Fishing in Red river, in Aroostook county, regulated. Resolved:** That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing the Red river, in Aroostook county, from Red River Falls to Poucheineer pond, after June 15th of each year, and establishing a daily bag limit of not more than 5 fish per person per day to be taken therefrom prior to June 15th of each year.
