STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Closing All the Waters of the State to Fishing Through the Ice for Salmon, Trout and Togue.

All waters of the state closed to fishing through the ice for salmon, trout and togue. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing all the waters of the state to fishing through the ice for salmon, trout and togue.
