STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Regulating Fishing in Big Magalloway River in Oxford County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 33, § 36, sub-§ III, amended. Subsection III of section 36 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following :

'Provided, however, it shall be lawful to fish Big Magalloway river in Oxford county between Aziscohos lake and Paramachenee dam until September 30th with artificial unbaited flies with a daily limit after September 15th of 1 fish per day per person.'
