STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Free Fishing Licenses to Recipients of Old Age Assistance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 32, sub-§ VIII, amended. Subsection VIII of section 32 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph to read as follows:

'A permit to fish shall be issued free of charge to all persons who receive old age assistance.'
