RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Wilson Stream in the County of Piscataquis.

Regulating fishing in Wilson stream in the county of Piscataquis. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Wilson stream, in the town of Willimantic, a tributary to Sebec lake, in the county of Piscataquis, to the taking of smelts from 6 o'clock in the morning to 6 o'clock in the evening of each day.
