RESOLVE Authorizing Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game to Sell Certain Buildings at Marshfield to Orris Bowker.

Authority to sell certain buildings granted to commissioner of inland fisheries and game. Resolved: That, the state having abandoned the land conveyed to it by Orris F. Bowker of Marshfield by deed dated July 23, 1929, which deed contained a condition subsequent that if the state ceased to use Smelt brook, so called, as a rearing station, title to the lot therein described shall revert to the said Orris F. Bowker and his heirs, authority is granted therefor to sell the buildings thereon in Marshfield, Washington county, to the said Bowker for \$50 and to quitclaim to him the land described in said deed for the same consideration, the deed to be executed in the name of the state by the commissioner of inland fisheries and game.
