STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Money Held in Trust for Cemetery Purposes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 54, § 17, amended. Section 17 of chapter 54 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 17. Cities and towns may hold money in trust for cemetery purposes. Any person owning or interested in a lot or lots in a public buryingground of a city or town may deposit with the treasurer of such city or town a sum of money not exceeding \$500 for the purpose of providing for the preservation and care of such lot or lots, or its their appurtenances, which sum shall be entered upon the books of the treasurer, and invested and held in accordance with the provisions of section 106 of chapter 80.'
