AN ACT Relating to Travel for Members of the Legislature

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 9, § 2, amended. The 1st sentence of section 2 of chapter 9 of the revised statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 362 of the public laws of 1943, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Each member of the senate and house of representatives shall receive \$850 for the regular session of the legislature, and \$2 for every to miles' travel from his place of abode once in each session shall be paid for travel at each legislative session once each week at the rate of 5c per mile to and from his place of abode; the mileage to be determined by the most reasonable direct route.'
