COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 1259, L. D. 558, Bill, "An Act to
Incorporate the Town of Corinth School
District."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 12th line of Sec. 4
thereof the figure "\$72,000" and inserting in place thereof the
figure '\$50,000'.

Further amend said Bill by inserting after the word "meeting"
in the next to the last sentence of Sec. 8 thereof, the following:

'; provided that the total number of votes cast for and against
the acceptance of this act at said meeting equals or exceeds 20%
of the total vote for all candidates for governor in said town at
the next previous gubernatorial election'
