RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Fryeburg.

Town of Fryeburg; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$12,215.59 from the general fund of the state to be paid to the town of Fryeburg in payment of bills owed by the town of Fryeburg for fire fighting services during the forest fires of 1947.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

There are bills to the amount of \$12,215.59 yet unpaid, owed by the town of Fryeburg for fire fighting services during the forest fires of 1947. These are bills that should be paid over and above the 1% valuation that the town has already taken care of.
