RESOLVE Regulating Fishing in Pleasant and Mud Lakes in the County of Penobscot.

Regulating fishing in Pleasant and Mud lakes in the county of Penobscot. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing Pleasant and Mud lakes, T. 6, R. 6, W. E. L. S., in the county of Penobscot and all tributaries thereto to all fishing except fly fishing and trolling.
