IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

RESOLVE Appropriating Money to Improve the Approach to the Fish Way at Aroostook Falls.

Fish way at Aroostook Falls; improving the approach of. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$2,241.04 to be taken from the general fund of the state and expended by and at the discretion of the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, if and when the money is available, for improving the approach to the fish way at Aroostook Falls on the Aroostook river in the province of New Brunswick; and be it further

Resolved: That any and all acts done in compliance with the provisions of this resolve in the province of New Brunswick shall be with the consent and approval of said province.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In 1947 the legislature appropriated the sum of \$3,000 from the general fund of the state for the purpose of improving the approach to the fish way at Aroostook Falls. Due to unforeseen conditions the necessary work cannot be completed prior to July 1, 1949, therefore, the purpose of this resolve is to reappropriate the unexpended balance.
