RESOLVE, Relative to Changing the Name of Umsaskis Lake to Dow Lake.

Relative to changing the name of Umsaskis lake to Dow lake. Resolved: That the name of that body of water in T. 10 and 11, R. 13, W. E. L. S., in Piscataquis and Aroostook counties, now known as Umsaskis lake, is hereby changed to Dow lake.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The purpose of this resolve is to commemorate the memory of the late Levi Dow of Plaisted who did so much to promote interest in the natural resources in the woodland areas of our state. Supervisor Dow sold the recreational assets of Maine throughout New England and was in his time the leading exponent of the Allagash and Fish River areas; no one person ever did as much to sell Maine.
