STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relative to Salaries of Inland Fisheries and Game Wardens.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 19, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 19 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘Sheriffs, deputy sheriffs, police officers and constables are vested with the powers of inland fish and game wardens, and shall receive for similar services the same fees as those of inland fish and game wardens. Fish and game wardens appointed under the provisions of section 20 **shall receive such salaries as shall be established by the state personnel board** and shall hold no other state, county or town office from which they receive compensation.’
