STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Park and Recreation Commission of City of South Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1933, c. 55, Article 12, § 7, amended. Section 7 of Article 12 of chapter 55 of the private and special laws of 1933, as enacted by chapter 61 of the private and special laws of 1945, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 7. Borrow money. Said commission in the name of the eity, with the approval by vote of the city council, shall have the power to borrow money and give notes or other evidences of indebtedness therefor, to carry on the work herein designated, which shall be repaid out of the fund herein established, but the city shall not be liable for the payment of any money so borrowed beyond the amount in said fund or deposited in said fund from time to time under the provisions of section sections 8 and 9 hereof. Any money borrowed by vote of the commission shall be repaid from said fund in the manner provided under the terms of the loan, and any installment, when due and payable, shall be a first lien on said fund.'
