AN ACT Relating to Regional Library Service.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 38, § 11-B, additional. Chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 11-B, to read as follows:

‘Sec. 11-B. In furtherance of, and in addition to, the powers given in section 11, the librarian of the state library is authorized and empowered to provide library service for all residents of the state, especially to rural schools and farm homes, through some system of regional libraries, book-mobiles or other agencies.’

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the state the sum of \$16,800 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1950, and the sum of \$12,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1951, for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of section 11-B of chapter 38 of the revised statutes.
