STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

RESOLVE Regulating Fishing in Moosehead Lake, in the County of Piscataquis.

Regulating fishing in Moosehead lake, in the county of Piscataquis. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue the following rules and regulations:

- I. Closing to ice fishing that part of Moosehead lake, in the town of Greenville, in the county of Piscataquis, from the mouth of Tomhegan stream to a line drawn from the easternmost part of Baker Brook point.
- II. Closing to ice fishing that part of Moosehead lake from the mouth of Moose brook to a line drawn from the easternmost part of the Toe-of-the-Boot through the largest island in Moose Brook cove and in a northerly direction to the opposite shore.
- III. Closing to ice fishing that part of Moosehead lake from the mouth of Socatean stream to a line drawn from the camp site known as the Ledges on the northerly shore of Socatean bay, southerly through Wiggin's island and continuing in a straight line to the westerly shore of Socatean bay.
