RESOLVE Regulating Fishing in Big Fish Lake, in the County of
Aroostook.

Regulating fishing in Big Fish lake, in the county of Aroostook. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing to all fishing the tributaries to Big Fish lake, in the county of Aroostook, except Mud and Carr ponds and the so called Chase lakes, and issue a further rule and regulation bringing the law which regulates fishing in that part of Big Fish lake which is in T. 14, R. 8 in the county of Aroostook to coincide with the law regulating fishing on the remainder of the lake.
