RESOLVE Regulating Fishing in Portage Lake, in the County of Aroostook.

Regulating fishing in Portage lake in the county of Aroostook. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Portage lake in the town of Portage Lake, in the county of Aroostook, to fishing through the ice for salmon, trout and togue from February I to April 30 of each year, with a daily bag limit of 10 pounds.
