AN ACT Relating to Rental for the Western Somerset Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1909, c. 331, § 6, amended. Section 6 of chapter 331 of the private and special laws of 1909 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 6. Municipal officers shall provide rooms for holding court; rental. The municipal officers of the towns of Skowhegan, Fairfield, Madison and Bingham shall provide suitable rooms and facilities for the holding of the sessions of said court, and all processes shall be made returnable accordingly. **Rental for such rooms or facilities in the town of Skowhegan shall be paid from the county of Somerset in quarterly payments in the sum of \$350 annually.'**
