COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1306, L. D. 633, Bill "An Act Forbidding Employers to Charge a Fee for a Medical Examination as a Condition of Employment."

Amend said Bill by striking out, in the 1st sentence of that part designated "Sec. 36-B", the underlined words "<u>or applicant for</u> <u>employment to pay the cost of a medical examination or the cost of</u> <u>furnishing any records required by the employer as a condition of</u> <u>employment</u>" and inserting in place thereof the underlined words '<u>to</u> <u>bear the medical expense of an examination when such examination is</u> <u>ordered or required by the employer</u>'

Further amend said Bill by striking out the underlined figure "\$100" in the 3rd line from the end and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '\$50'
