COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1306, L. D. 633, Bill "An Act
Forbidding Employers to Charge a Fee for a
Medical Examination as a Condition of Em-
ployment."

Amend said Bill by striking out, in the 1st sentence of that
part designated "Sec. 36-B", the underlined words "or applicant for
employment to pay the cost of a medical examination or the cost of
furnishing any records required by the employer as a condition of
employment" and inserting in place thereof the underlined words 'to
bear the medical expense of an examination when such examination is
ordered or required by the employer'

Further amend said Bill by striking out the underlined figure
"\$100" in the 3rd line from the end and inserting in place thereof
the underlined figure '\$50'
