IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Licenses for Junk Dealers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 88, § 100, amended. Section 100 of chapter 88 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 100. Licenses of pawnbrokers and junk dealers; terms; penalty. The municipal officers of any town may grant licenses to persons of good moral character to be pawnbrokers or junk dealers therein for 1 year, unless sooner revoked by said officers for violation of law. Whoever carries on said business businesses without a license forfeits not more than \$100.'
