AN ACT Relating to Lights on Certain Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 34, amended. The 1st sentence of the 4th paragraph of section 34 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Every such motor vehicle, tractor and trailer shall have on the rear thereof ~~and to the left of the axis thereof~~ 1 lamp capable of displaying a red light visible for a distance of at least 100 feet behind such vehicle; provided that when a vehicle is used in conjunction with another vehicle or vehicles, only the last of such vehicles shall be required to carry such lamp.'
