RESOLVE Authorizing the Trustees of Town of Houlton School District
to Convey Certain Land to the State of Maine.

Trustees of Town of Houlton School District authorized to convey land.
Resolved: That the trustees of the Town of Houlton School District be, and hereby are, authorized to convey approximately 5 acres of the Bird farm, so called, in the town of Houlton, to the state of Maine for armory purposes.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The present armory lot is too small. The trustees of the Town of Houlton School District hold title to approximately 100 acres of land, the Bird farm, so called, from which they will deed to the state approximately 5 acres for the new armory.
