RESOLVE Appropriating Moneys to Continue the Cost of Living Increases
of State Employees.

Cost of living increases of state employees, continued. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated such sums as may be required by the respective departments of state government so as to continue in effect for the fiscal years of 1949-50 and 1950-51 the cost of living increases in effect on January 1, 1949. The intent of this resolve shall be to continue at the rate of \$7 per week the provisions of chapter 188 of the private and special laws of 1947 and to continue in effect the wage rate adjustments provided for by the personnel board on October 4, 1948.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The state employees have been granted a cost-of-living increase under chapter 188 of the private and special laws of 1947 and a further rate adjustment by the personnel board. The purpose of this appropriation is to continue such wage rate adjustments.
