AN ACT Relative to Stockholm Game Preserve.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 128, amended. Section 128 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto, in alphabetical order, a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'Stockholm Game Preserve: The following described territory, situated in the town of Stockholm and T. 16, R. 4, in the county of Aroostook beginning at a point on state road No. 161 at a point where Bangor & Aroostook R. R. crosses said highway and extending in a northerly direction approximately 6 miles to the southern boundary of T. 17, R. 3, thence west along southern boundary of T. 17, R. 3 also T. 17, R. 4, to highway 161 in a southeasterly direction to point of beginning; the above described area containing approximately 12,000 acres.'
