IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

RESOLVE in Favor of the Town of Appleton.

Town of Appleton; appropriation for. Resolved: That the money appropriated in favor of the town of Appleton by the 93rd legislature for the fiscal year 1948-49 for repairing the road leading from Belfast turn, so called, on route No. 131 to Pitman's corner, so called, on Appleton Ridge, be and hereby is reappropriated in favor of the town of Appleton to be expended for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1950, in repairing the Ridge road, so called, leading from Pease corner through Pitman's corner, so called, to Searsmont town line.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This road is in need of repair and the appropriation made by the 93rd legislature, through error, was designated for the road leading from Belfast turn to Pitman's corner.
