STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relative to Bounty on Bobcat, Loupcervier and Canada Lynx in the County of Aroostook.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 102, amended. The 1st sentence of section 102 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

There shall be a bounty of \$\frac{\pmathbb{FT}}{\pmathbb{FT}}\$\$ \$25\$ for every bobcat, loupcervier and Canada lynx which is killed within the state county of Aroostook, to be paid by the treasurer of state to the person killing the same upon compliance with the following conditions.'
