STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Veterinary Surgery.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 70, § 4, amended. The last sentence of section 4 of chapter 70 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter 189 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Nothing in this section shall be construed as prohibiting the performance of services rendered by anyone in the case of emergency, or prohibiting any person from practicing veterinary medicine, surgery or dentistry on any animal belonging to himself; nor shall this section be construed as prohibiting castration of ~~male~~ animals by any resident of this state.'
