STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Application of General Law to Community Schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 92-H, amended. Section 92-H of chapter 37 of the revised statutes, as enacted by chapter 357 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 92-H. Application of general law. Community schools as herein provided when established, not over 12 miles from participating towns, may be considered the official secondary schools of said participating towns and all provisions of the general law relating to public education shall apply to said schools.'
