AN ACT Relating to Licensing of Sellers of Bait for Trapping.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 106-B, additional. Chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 106-B, to read as follows:

'Sec. 106-B. Lure dealer's license; fee. No person shall sell or offer for sale any bait, lure or other substance designed to attract animals to traps by scent unless licensed as a lure dealer. The annual fee for a lure dealer's license shall be \$25.'
