AN ACT Relating to Open Season on Muskrats.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 97, sub-§ I, amended. The 3rd and 4th paragraphs of subsection I of section 97 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, are hereby amended to read as follows:

‘There shall be an open season on muskrats in the counties of **Aroostook**, Franklin, Hancock, Penobscot (except as prohibited in section 99), Piscataquis, Somerset and Oxford from ~~November 17th to November 30th and from~~ April 10th to April ~~25th~~ 30th, inclusive; Kennebec and Washington, from April 1st to the following April 30th, inclusive, in each calendar year.

~~There shall be an open season on muskrats in the county of Aroostook from November 17th to November 30th and from April 26th to the following May 15th, inclusive, in each calendar year.’~~
