AN ACT Relative to Restricting the Use of Power Boats on Portage Lake
in the County of Aroostook.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 56-B, additional. Chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 56-B, to read as follows:

‘Sec. 56-B. Restricting the use of power boats. No person shall operate any boat or canoe propelled by motor on that portion of Portage lake in townships T. 13, R. 6, W. E. L. S., county of Aroostook, known as the Floating Island Area, north and westerly of a line beginning at the eastern edge of the marshy peninsula running out from Hutchinson ridge, running 50 yards outside of the floating islands in a northerly direction to the mouth of Mosquito brook.’
