**AN ACT Relating to Pollution of Tidal Waters.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 72, § 6, amended.** The 1st sentence of section 6 of chapter 72 of the revised statutes, as enacted by section 3 of chapter 266 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'No person, corporation or other party shall place or deposit in the inland waters or tidal waters of this state, or on the banks thereof in such a manner that the same shall fall or be washed into such waters, any slabs, edgings, sawdust, chips, bark, mill waste, shavings or fibrous materials created in the manufacture of lumber or other wood products, or so deposit any oil regardless of its source, or pollute said waters in manner and extent inconsistent with the public interest.'
