STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Relating to the Use of Purse, Drag or Stop Seines in Damariscotta River.

Use of purse, drag or stop seines in Damariscotta river. Resolved: That the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to repeal the rule and regulation which prohibits any person from using any purse, drag or stop seine for all fish except alewives in Damariscotta river above a line drawn from Farnham's head in the town of Boothbay to a point opposite on the shore in the town of Bristol, excepting the use of drag seines between the above line and The Ledges.
