RESOLVE Opening Bagaduce River, in Hancock County, to Trapping of Eels.

Bagaduce river, Hancock county, opened to trapping for eels. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Bagaduce river and its tributaries, in Hancock county, to the trapping of eels.
