STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of a Bridge Across the St. John River in Allagash Plantation.

Bridge to be constructed over St. John river. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general highway fund, the sum of \$210,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1950, to build a bridge across the St. John river in Allagash plantation, at or near the "present ferry site" in cooperation with the county of Aroostook and the plantation of Allagash. Any unexpended balance shall not lapse but shall be available for any succeeding fiscal year.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This bridge is to take the place of the ferry which is totally inadequate for the traffic crossing this river.
